#### Information

- provides comprehensive information on government licences or permits for running different businesses and starting a business in Hong Kong;
- establishes a user-friendly website (www.success. tid.gov.hk) which is a ready source to look for information on SME-related activities, services and facilities;
- provides free access to useful electronic business databases;
- displays practical business reference materials in a reference library; and
- publishes a regular publication –"SME Pulse" on SME topical issues.

SUCCESS also organises and supports seminars, workshops and other activities on a regular basis on issues of concern to SMEs to help broaden SMEs' business knowledge and enhance their entrepreneurial skills.
