The program comprises:

1. Organization of Career Talks

HAFFA collaborated with various Tertiary Institutes to organize a series of career talks for their students whom are studying logistics related courses and/or are about to graduate. In the talks, HAFFA representative introduced our industry and presented career opportunities through different forms of presentation or interaction with their students / targeted groups. Members were invited to join the career talk in which they could meet the students face-to-face, distribute their business cards or even conduct on-the-spot recruitment (at some institutes) with the graduates.
