HAFFA Becomes First Accredited CBTA Dangerous Goods Awareness Training Trade Association under HKCAD

Under the evolution from traditional learning to CBTA, as agreed by the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO), HAFFA has long been the only training provider to produce a comprehensive HKCAD-approved DG Awareness Self-Study Manual. The manual contains case studies, self-study exercises, DG labels and illustrations, and is designed to save industry practitioners both time and costs as well as to enable pace-of-learning flexibility.

HAFFA's DGA 0.5-day Classroom course and DGA Self Study Examination, all approved by HKCAD and complying with 2023 CBTA and scheduled in January and February 2023, are now open for registration.
